



Making the most of your next SOS event at North Myrtle Beach

CLUBS

The three most popular shag night clubs are Fat Harold's, Ducks, and OD Arcade. Two others are HOTO's, located inside the OD Resort, and the OD Pavillion, an open-air venue in-season. The Spanish Galleon, located inside the OD Resort, features bands in the evenings but there is a fee to reserve a table or chairs.

Fat Harold's: Seems to be the busiest. Seating is very limited in the evenings and when bands are featured in the afternoons. There are 2 rooms, the front and the back. The front dance floor gets very crowded at night. More experienced dancers seem to prefer the back room. A vendor sells ladies' shag shoes there on the mornings of those classes during SOS. If you go for a band or to dance in the evening, get there EARLY. It is a packed house every night. The back lounge is a little less crowded. Not a lot of seating in general so be prepared to stand. Lots of great dancing to see here. Fat Harold's normally will have The Embers and Band of Oz on selected nights.

Ducks: There are 2 rooms with dance floors that are smaller than Fat Harold's. Steve Balock and Myers Floyd teach here during SOS. Ducks recently seemed to transition generally to a younger (non-SOS) country crowd.

OD Arcade: Located one block south of Main Street. The OD Arcade has the most seating. Great food makes it a popular lunch location. The dance floor does not seem to be as crowded as the previous two clubs. Great place to socialize in the afternoons. A nice place to end the day with a drink and snack and see some great dancing.

HOTO's: Requires a food or beverage purchase for seating. There is a nice large dance floor surrounded by dining tables, large menu selection with fresh food, easy to get to the Spanish Galleon from here

OD Pavillion: Unfinished plywood dance floor. Open-air ocean front venue. Mostly "older" beach music.

Spanish Galleon Beach Club: Evening hours only. Reservations and a fee are required for seating. \$80 for a table for four. Features beach music bands with a small dance floor, more of a concert environment with some great Shag Bands. Spanish Galleon normally will have The Embers and Band of Oz on selected nights. Deckerz: Inside is very small so get there early before the entertainment starts if you want a seat.
